Hands-on veterinary skills training designed to build confidence in new graduates

This year's boot camp provides small group lectures and hands-on instruction in dermatology, leadership/mentorship, soft tissue surgery and dentistry, giving veterinarians post-graduation the skills they can immediately apply in practice..
